





2022 New Noir "Late" — Willamette Valley

Maison Noir Wines: Garage Wines (Micro-Negociant) focusing on specific terroirs in Oregon by sourcing the best fruit possible from the Willamette Valley region of Oregon to produce wines which show the individuality of their respected sites.

Grapes: We source our fruit from several of the finest vineyards in the Willamette Valley, it is this combination of grapes from a variety of appellations that creates a wine that is broad and complex with many layers.

Winemaking: The 2022 vintage, started out relatively cool but continued dry in the valley, which lead to superb fruit and producing fresh and complex wines. The Pinot Gris, saw 22 days of skin contact and co-fermented (w/ all grapes) in stainless steel. The 2022 **New Noir** is a skin contact "Northwest Edelzwicker" of sorts, a diabolical blend of 42% Gewurztraminer, 36% Pinot Gris, 12% Riesling, 5% Muscat, and 5% Pinot Blanc: Stone fruit potpourri, racy acidity with a sprinkle of molten salt!"
